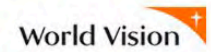

Recommendations - Pastoral/Rangeland System Restoration

Action	Who leads
Strengthen coordination of agencies in rangelands restoration for scaling	Government
Land use planning, the County Spatial Plans	County Government
Design specific capacity building approaches internalizing the unique needs of pasture/rangelands - tree planting; grassland and cropland restoration; ANR; holistic grazing and management	Non – state actors; Planners, decision makers and implementation projects
Integrating indigenous with scientific knowledge and use it for evidence based decision making	Implementing agencies (GOs, NGOs, ...)
Communication and documentation of land restoration efforts, what is working and how it is spreading	Implementing agencies (GOs, NGOs, ...)
Harmonize monitoring processes for restoration projects	All practitioners, implementing agencies,
Including the agenda of restoration in University Curriculum	Academia
Joint planning and joint resource mobilization	Restoration project planners, development partners
Mainstreaming gender issues: women access and control	All stakeholders participating in restoration efforts
Joint planning in the counties - cascade restoration targets to county level	County Governments and all stakeholders.
Stakeholder Mapping and enhancing joined planning and resource mobilization	All stakeholders participating in restoration efforts

Recommendations – Forest landscapes

Action	Who leads
There is a Benefit Sharing regulation under development by KEFRI, KFS and NACOFA to ensure equal benefit sharing	KEFRI
Authorities in charge of the infrastructural development can replant trees and create more green spaces.	
Find ways to work with faith communities because they have resources e.g. land and the influence over their followers.	KFS and others
Do a massive campaign and raise awareness	KFS
Have one App being used across the board as they are many	KEFRI
Work with faith communities to ensure restoration as they have mass influence over their following	NACOFA
Quantify aerial seeding success rates	KEFRI
Ensure counties are buying into and rolling out into the restoration implementation	KFS and counties
Promote restoration technologies and create waraenes	KEFRI

Create communication networks among stakeholders in restoration efforts	KFS
Coordinate restoration related CSR activities at national and county government levels for example have an almanac of all national events circulated to stakeholders	Ministry of Environment/COG
Provide a framework for Cascading the PET plastics project by WCK to other institutions of learning	Ministry of Environment and Forestry/WCK/NEMA
Consider holistic approach to restoration by revising goals objectives and workplans	All restoration stakeholders
