

## MAIN SUCCESSES







Restoration practices have reached over 200,000 hectares of land



Over 45,000 households have taken up restoration activities



11,920 lead farmers and fire volunteers were trained in FMNR and bushfire management across program sites



17,550 farmers have benefited from conservation agriculture and compost training



100+ communal FMNR fields across the program sites have been established, accounting for over 10,000 hectares



Over 200,000 seedlings planted cumulatively over the last 5 years across program sites



Business plans for one strategic actor were developed in each district to promote the shea value chain



The program have worked towards gender and financial inclusion by introducing S4T interventions to 6,500 beneficiaries (87% female) in the Bawku West and Tempane District



Regreening Africa supported the establishment of Environmental Management Committees at the

district level to support the implementation of environmental by-laws and advise on environmental issues. 40 communities have established by-laws in the Bawku West and Garu Tempane districts



Regreening Africa has proved critical support to the development of the Northern Ghana Restoration Initiative



Radio Communication and visibility campaigns reached thousands, spreading messages of Regreening practices and sustainable land management
